I am directed to invite a reference to the subject cited above and to say that the Governor of Punjab is pleased to decide that all the Government employees who are working on the posts having pay scales in Pay Band-1, Pay Band-2 and Pay Band-3, as shown in the Schedule appended to the Punjab Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 2009, shall be entitled to a Special Grade Pay of Rs. 150 with effect from 1st December, 2011, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) The Special Grade Pay admissible under these orders shall be *sui generis* and shall not be merged in the Grade Pay attached with the Pay Band of the relevant post.
