The 12th February, 1971

No. 375-FR(PRC)-71/2802.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Punjab Civil Services (Revised Scales of Pay) Rules, 1969, namely:—

✓ 1. *Short title and commencement.*—(1) These rules may be called the Punjab Civil Services (Revised Scales of Pay) (Amendment) Rules, 1971.

✓ (2) These rules, excepting rule 3(ii) which shall come into force at once, shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from 1st February, 1968.
