Payment of arrears of pension/family pension/extraordinary pension.



I am directed to invite a reference to Government letter No. 3/23/09-3FPPC/879 dated 17-8-2009, 3/23/09-3FPPC/885 dated 17-8-2009 and 3/39/09-3FPPC/201 dated 22nd February, 2010 and to say that the Governor of Punjab is pleased to decide that the arrears of pension/family pension/extraordinary pension for the period from 1-1-2006 to 31-7-2009 shall vest and become payable in cash in three equal instalments as detailed below:-

- (a) The first installment shall vest on 1.11.2010 and shall be paid alongwith the pension for the month of November, 2010.
 - (b) The second installment shall vest on 1-11-2011 and shall be paid alongwith the pension for the month of November, 2011.
 - (c) The third installment shall vest on 1-11-2012 and shall be paid alongwith the pension for the month of November, 2012.
2. All the District Treasury Officers/Treasury Officers and Public Sector Banks will make payment of arrears of pension/family pension/extraordinary pension on the basis of these orders.
 3. Punjabi version of these orders will follow in due course.


Subject: - Implementation of the recommendations of the Fifth Punjab Pay Commission –Payment of arrears of pension/family pension/extraordinary pension.





Subject: - Implementation of the recommendations of the Fifth Punjab Pay Commission regarding pension and other retirement benefits.


Sir/Madam,

I am directed to say that in partial modification of Government letter No. 3/23/09-3FPPC/879, dated 17-8-2009, on the subject cited above and to clarify the position regarding payment of ex-gratia grants for death of a Government employee under different circumstances, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to decide that the existing para 8 of the letter under reference, shall be substituted by the following para, namely.-

"8 Ex-gratia payment

- (a) Where death occurs in harness or the employee is permanently disabled and rendered unfit for further service, the exgratia payment shall be made at the rate of Rs. 1, 00,000/- (Rs. one lac only) on a uniform basis.
 - (b) Where death occurs in harness due to causes attributable to service i.e. for reasons which are directly or substantially connected with the performance of official duties and is clearly relatable to performance of such duties, the payment of exgratia shall be equal to 24 times the revised basic pay of the employee on the date of his/her death, with a minimum of Rs. 2.00 lacs and maximum of Rs. 4.00 lacs.
 - (c) If death occurs in performance of duty such as dealing with riots, terrorist attack or enemy action, ex-gratia shall be paid @ Rs. 10.00 lacs on a uniform basis."
3. The other terms and conditions for grant of ex-gratia shall continue to be in force.
 4. These orders shall be deemed to have come into force retrospectively i.e. with effect from the 1st day of January, 2006.
 5. The necessary amendments in the rules shall be made in due course.
 6. The Punjabi version of these orders shall follow in due course.
