Subject: Regarding concurrence of Finance Department with Pension Cases where decision of Hon'ble Courts are beyond the Punjab Civil Services Rules/instructions of Department of Finance.

Sir/Madam,


I am directed to invite reference on the subject cited above and to write that office of Accountant General Punjab (A&E) has brought to the notice of the Finance Department that the Departments are forwarding the pension cases, involving the judgements of the Hon'ble Courts in which decisions relating to pension cases are beyond Punjab Civil Services Rules and Instructions issued by the Finance Department, to the office of the Accountant General (A&E), Punjab.

2. In this connection, it is stated that sometimes the orders of the Hon'ble Courts are beyond the Punjab Civil Services Rules and instructions of the Government issued from time to time for pensionary benefits. In such cases the approval of Department of Finance is required since the competent authority for the interpretation of these rules is the Department of Finance and some decisions of the Hon'ble Courts are such which deserve to be implemented uniformly in like cases and some time policy decisions are also required to be taken for maintaining uniformity in disposal of other similar cases.

3. It has, therefore, been decided that the the Departments should thoroughly examine the pension cases where the judgements are beyond the rules/instructions of the Department of Finance first at their own level and thereafter forward the proposal to the Department of Finance for necessary concurrence before these are submitted to the office of Accountant General (A&E), Punjab for necessary action.

4. The instructions shall come in force with immediate effect.
